Important Information

All U.S. Italian Consulates are only able to process student visas of students who permanently reside or attend school in their jurisdiction. Students must apply within their correct jurisdiction and provide the correct proof of residency in their student visa application. Only students attending programs with a duration over 90 days may apply for a student visa.

This guide is intended to get students started on their student visa process by determining their consular jurisdiction. Students should <u>always</u> confirm the requirements directly on the consulate's website, as they reserve the right to change their requirements and procedures without notice.
